Hear ye, hear ye, brush off your accordions and dancing shoes, it's time for the Hope talent show! If you have a special talent, this is a time to share it with the whole school! Our Hope talent scouts are looking for show acts that meet the following guidelines:

- Variety of talent (skits, songs, sports, dance, etc.) and talent ability
- Variety of ages
- Appropriate for young children to watch
- Students limit themselves to one act, to allow time for everyone who wants to perform

### Audition Information

Auditions will be held in the Hope Commons, with the exception of piano which will be in the sanctuary. While acts will not be judged and this is more of a light-hearted talent show, practicing before auditions is highly recommended. Tryouts will begin at 3:10 PM.

- Younger students and students who need assistance with their performance should have an adult at auditions, as judges will not be able to supervise or assist students waiting. Please remain quiet while waiting to audition as others will be auditioning themselves.
- Students are welcome to attend any of the 3 audition dates but please mark which date you think you will attend, and make a note on your calendar. Please notify the school office if you need to change your audition date.
- Auditions times will go roughly in grade order, youngest to oldest.
- **If you child's act will be accompanied by a song, please send that song to Julie Hartley at [jhartley@hopeseattle.org](mailto:jhartley@hopeseattle.org) PRIOR to the audition to simplify the audition process.**
- Audition equipment includes chairs and a music stand. If other equipment is needed for auditions, please bring it in.
- Judges will give feedback intended to improve the performance for the talent show, so students should be prepared to listen carefully after auditioning.

### Performance Information

- Equipment available at the gym includes one mic, a sound system, MP3 player and chairs; if other equipment is needed including a keyboard, please plan to bring it in for the show.
- Songs must be emailed to Julie Hartley prior to auditions, see audition information above.
- Younger students and students who need assistance with their performance should have an adult available to assist them prior to the show, and please sit in a location in the stands that is easy to exit if they need assistance right before their actual performance, so the show is not delayed.
