1. You must have “permission to run” for office form (see attached) signed by your parent/guardian, and yourself. This is due **Mon. Oct 1**.
2. You must keep your grades in good standing throughout the school year.
3. Your behavior must remain in good standing and serve as an example to your peers.
4. 8th Grade Officer Positions include:
 - President
 - Vice President
 - Secretary
 - Treasurer
5. Grades 3-7 may elect 2 class representatives for each class
6. “Permission to run” slip is due on Mon. Oct 1. **The campaign will begin on Wed. Oct 3 and posters may be placed in the hallway at that time (one upstairs and one downstairs).**
7. **Speech presentations will take place on Wed. Oct. 10. 8th graders will do them after chapel and 3-7 graders will do them in their classrooms**
 - a. You may show signs/posters during or after your speech
 - b. You should tell the audience what your qualifications for office are and what you plan to do to help the school.
 - c. You may include ideas for new events.
 - d. Do not promise things you cannot deliver such as a soda machine or no homework!
8. No negative campaigns will be tolerated. Remember that you are running for yourself, not against someone else. Let’s hear lots of positive school spirit!
9. You must be able to attend monthly meetings at 7:45 am on the first Tuesday of the month.
10. You must be able to attend and help with most school events (such as Open House,

Student Council Officer Positions

President (8th Grade):

The president will serve as head of Student Council and will be in charge of leading our meetings. The president will also serve in various leadership roles throughout the year as needed, as well as attending other special events at Hope. The President will lead the Council, and will work in close conjunction with the Student Council Teacher in order to plan and execute special events.

Vice President (8th Grade):

The vice president will work closely with the president. The vice president will also serve in the absence of the president. The vice president will communicate to the school and head important events along side the president and the Student Council Teacher.

Secretary (8th Grade):

The secretary will be responsible for recording minutes for each Student Council meeting. Skills with typing and/or neat handwriting are recommended. The Secretary may also lead the council in creating posters, flyers, and other print publications as needed for the Council.

Treasurer (8th Grade):

The treasurer will be responsible for helping to coordinate the council budget. This will mean keeping track of the current budget and updating the budget after each function with which money is involved.

Class Representatives (Grades 3-7):

Representatives will attend Student Council meetings and contribute ideas and help with Student Council events as needed.
