



## TUITION AND FEES FOR 2025-2026

### REGISTRATION AND DEPOSIT FEES

Registration fees are non-refundable, per student fees that reserve a child's place in class. These fees are due upon application or re-enrollment.

Preschool and Kindergarten through 8th Grade: \$200  
 New Family Deposit, Preschool – 8<sup>th</sup> Grade \$150\*

*\*(Fee is refundable, per family, and deposit is applied to tuition upon acceptance.)*

### NEW STUDENTS

- A \$150 deposit is required for each new family at the time of application, in addition to registration fees. This deposit is refundable if the student is not accepted into the school. If the student is accepted, the deposit is applied to tuition.
- A testing fee of \$40 will be collected for all new applicants for kindergarten through 8th Grade.



## REGISTRATION AND TUITION

- Registration fee includes an annual yearbook.
- Tuition covers instruction, textbooks, classroom supplies and the Outdoor Education Trip for 6th Graders. It does not cover field/class trips.
- The “1st Child” rates apply to the child in the highest grade.
- A \$200 tuition discount is given to families enrolling a Preschooler and a child in kindergarten through 8th Grade.
- The monthly rates shown are based on the 10-month payment option.

## TUITION ASSISTANCE

Tuition assistance funds are available to help families with financial need. Tuition assistance grants are awarded based on availability of funds and on recommendation from the National Association Independent School (NAIS), which evaluates ability to pay via application. Applications must be submitted for each school year as grants are not automatically renewed. Applications are submitted online, and instructions are available through the school office. Applications must be submitted to NAIS no later than April 30th to be assured consideration for the 2025-2026 school year. Applicant information is kept strictly confidential.

## TUITION PAYMENT OPTIONS

In Full:	By July 1st
2 Payments:	½ full amount in August and January
10-Month:	10 equal payments (August – May)
12-Month:	12 equal payments (July - June)

The 2 payment, 10-Month and 12-Month payment options require the use of Blackbaud Tuition Service. The administrative fee for using this service will be added to your contract with Blackbaud.

Administrative Fee:	\$56 per year
Follow-up Fee (late fee):	\$60 per late payment

Tuition invoices and detailed instructions for payment will be sent out in April 2025.

## NEW FAMILY REFERRAL DISCOUNT

Current enrolled families referring new families to Hope School who enroll and remain in good financial standing through January 2026 will receive a \$1000 tuition credit.

## PARENT INVOLVEMENT PROGRAM (PIP)

PIP Value: \$900

Kindergarten through 8th grade families are required to volunteer 30 hours (15 hours for single families) towards school activities. If these hours are not fulfilled, a rate of \$30 per unfulfilled hour will be assessed. Please reference the School Handbook for complete details.

## WITHDRAWALS

Should a family decide to withdraw a student from school during the school year, the tuition related to that student will be assessed through the end of current school trimester plus an administrative withdrawal fee of \$100 per family.
